Fire Policy.

Frigoken Limited is committed to developing, maintaining and sustaining a Fire Policy based on internationally recognized ISO 14001:2015 and Fire Risk Reduction Rules 2007.

Management of fire risks will be undertaken in such a way as to prevent injury or ill-health to employees, visitors, contractors and others who may be affected by the activities of the Organization.

The company shall take steps to prevent, or minimize the probability of all causes of fire;

- Ensure systems are in place to deal with fire incidences and liaison with the local fire authorities where applicable.
- Prepare a suitable and sufficient fire emergency plan, regularly review the plan and practice by carrying out fire drills and safety inspections/audits regularly.
- Undertake suitable and sufficient fire risk assessments of all premises and activities within premises. Identify and implement reasonably practicable control measures to control risks from fire.
- Provide employees with comprehensible and relevant information regarding the hazards identified from the risk assessment, the preventive and protective measures, the fire emergency plan, and the identities of persons nominated to carry out the duties of the emergency response team.
- Ensure maintenance and inspection of fire fighting appliances and fire detection systems.
- Train workers on fire fighting techniques.
- Assign responsibilities to individual persons within the organizations for fire prevention and control.

This policy will be reviewed annually as a minimum, communicated throughout the company and availed to other stakeholders on request.
